HD1. Entry Fee: \$65

Prize Money: \$300, \$250, \$200, \$100, \$70, \$50, \$30

Open to all horses and riders who compete in at least one regular Hunter division at this show. The first round (Classic Round) will consist of a hunter course of 8 jumps set with two higher option fences, worth 2 bonus points each. Rounds will be scored, with the top 8 invited back for the Handy Round.

Combined scores from both the Classic and Handy Rounds will determine overall placing.

No Schooling over course prior to derby. Order of go determined by draw, one hour prior to event start. 3' fence height will go first.

Ribbons and prize money through 8th place. Riders will ride for ribbons.

Fences 2', 2'6" and 3'.

**\$600 Jumper Four Bar Class

HD1. Entry Fee: \$65

Prize Money: \$300, \$200, \$100

Order will be drawn one hour before the class starts. All horses will enter the ring and remain until the end of the class. First round jumps will be 2'6", second 2'9", third 3', fourth 3'3" with two strides between each of the vertical jumps. The first and second jumps will remain at their preliminary height for the class. Each horse who completes the four bar without faults will be eligible to move on to the next round. The jumps will be raised until only one horse and rider remain.

Ribbons and prize money through 8th place. Riders will ride for ribbons.

Ties will remain tied and prize money split accordingly.

2026 DIVISION SPECIFICATIONS.

EQUITATION & HUNTER DIVISIONS

SHORT/LONG STIRRUP - Fences set at 18"-2'. Can be combined if less than 3 in either section.

Cross entering allowed in divisions where fences do not exceed 2'3". No Oxers

SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER - riders 12 years and under who have not jumped higher than 2'3" at any show. (LHJA)

SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION - riders 12 years and under who have not jumped higher than 2'3" at any show (LHJA)

LONG STIRRUP HUNTER - Junior & amateur over 12 years of age who have not jumped higher than 2'3" at any show (LHJA)

RUSTY STIRRUP HUNTER - Open to all horses and riders. Fences 18"-2' No oxers.

RUSTY STIRRUP EQUITATION - Open to all horses and riders. Fences 18"-2' No oxers

LONG STIRRUP EQUITATION - Junior & amateur over 12 years of age who have not jumped higher than 2'3" at any show. (LHJA)

NOVICE HUNTER - Fences set at 2'3" Open to junior and amateur riders. No oxers. Riders may not cross enter into classes where the fences are 2'9" or higher. (LHJA)

NOVICE EQUITATION - Fences set at 2'3" Open to junior and amateur riders. No oxers. Riders may not cross enter into classes where the fences are 2'9" or higher. (LHJA)

PRE-CHILDREN'S HUNTER - Open to any junior or amateur on a horse or pony. Rider may not cross enter where fences exceed 2'9". Fences 2'3"-2'6". (LHJA)

PRE-ADULT HUNTER - Open to any junior or amateur on a horse or pony. Rider may not cross enter where fences exceed 2'9". Fences 2'3"-2'6". (LHJA)

OPEN EQUITATION - Open to all riders. Fences set at 2'6" 3' or higher (LHJA)

OPEN 2'6" HUNTER - Open to all horses and riders

MODIFIED CHILD/ADULT HUNTER - Open to Junior and Amateur riders. Fences 2'9" (LHJA)

MEDAL CLASSES

LHJA MICRO MEDAL - 2'3" Open to all juniors and amateurs who have not jumped 2'9" (LHJA)

LHJA MINI MEDAL - 2'6" Open to all juniors and amateurs who have not jumped

BEGINNER RIDER DIVISIONS

WALK POLES - Beginner riders who have not trotted at a horse show

WALK TROT EQUITATION - Open to beginner riders who have NEVER CANTERED or JUMPED at any show. Rider may not cross enter into any other division (LHJA)

WALK, TROT, CANTER - Beginner riders who have not jumped over fences 2' or higher at any show

WALK TROT POLES - Beginner riders who have never shown in a class where cantering a jump is required.

WALK TROT CANTER POLES - Beginner riders who have never shown in a class where cantering a jump is required

TROT X RAIL EQUITATION - Beginner riders who have NEVER shown in a class where cantering a jump is required. Rider may cross enter into the Advanced Beginner Trot X or the Walk, Trot, Canter, but not both. (LHJA)

ADVANCED BEGINNER TROT X - Open to beginner riders who have not jumped fences 2' or higher at any show. Rider may cross enter into Trot X Rail Equitation or Mini Stirrup Equitation, but not both.

MINI STIRRUP EQUITATION - Open to beginners who have not jumped 2' or higher in classes at any show. Riders will trot the "X" and canter the vertical out of the line. Rider may cross enter into Advanced Trot X or Pre-Short/ Long Stirrup, but not both. (LHJA)

PRE-SHORT/ LONG STIRRUP HUNTER - Open to beginner riders of all ages who have not jumped higher than 2' at any show. Canter 1' vertical course. (LHJA)

JUMPER DIVISIONS

HOPEFUL JUMPER: .75m Open to all horses and riders. Rider can not jump higher than 1.05m at this show. (LHJA)

LOW CHILD/ADULT JUMPER .80m Open to junior and amateur riders. (LHJA)

OPEN 1m JUMPER- Open to all horses and riders.

Courtesy Circle, Jump Orders and A "Clock on the Gate"

A dotted line may be put into effect at Management's discretion. A rotating jump order will be established and posted for jumper classes. All horses must be ridden in the posted order. Riders and trainers with conflicts due to multiple entries in a class must see the starter so that necessary adjustments can be made. If management deems that unnecessary delays have been a problem, a 3 minute clock will be placed on the in-gate of the problem ring. After time has expired and there has not been an exhibitor in the show ring, the class in progress will end.

Horse Show Office

The horse show office will be open 1 hour prior to the start of the show each day. No numbers will be issued without an open check filed with the show secretary.

Motorized Vehicle Statement

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the grounds.

To be eligible for any under saddle/flat class, the horse and rider must be entered and shown in at least one of the over fence class in that division. No horse or rider may enter the show ring 'not to be judged'.

A negative coggins test must be presented before numbers will be issued. Coggins must be valid according to the laws of Louisiana. No one may ride in any class or schooling area without a hard hat. When mounted, all riders must wear ASTM protective headgear in accordance with current USEF rules.
